XXV annual symposium of the Dutch Thyroid Research Foundation

The Dutch Thyroid Research Foundation cordially invites you to the 25th edition of its annual symposium, which will take place on June 23th 2023 at the **Trippenhuis in Amsterdam**. International and Dutch experts will highlight important recent developments in basic and clinical thyroidology.

The symposium will start with a session on the metabolic effects of thyroid hormone. Prof Krish Chatterjee (Cambridge, UK) will discuss these effects based on studies performed with patients with resistance to thyroid hormone. Dr. Eveline Bruinstroop (AmsterdamUMC) will show the novel insights in thyroid hormone-based treatment of NAFLD followed by Dr. Layal Chaker (ErasmusMC) with a presentation on the relation between thyroid hormone, cardio-vascular parameters and TSH setpoint. The session ends with a presentation of Prof. Kristien Boelaert (Birmingham, UK) on the cardio-metabolic consequences and mortality following treatment for hyperthyroidism.

After lunch we will start with six short presentations selected from submitted abstracts.

The focus will then shift to thyroid cancer with two renowned speakers; Miguel Melo (University of Coimbra) will discuss the aspects of intermediate risk thyroid carcinoma and Prof. Schelto Kruijff (UMCG Groningen) will share the recent insights in surgical approach of thyroid cancer in the Netherlands. Dr Warner Simonides will end the 25th edition of the Dutch Thyroid Day with a historic overview of the Dutch Thyroid Research Foundation!

We look forward to an exciting meeting and hope to see you in Amsterdam!
